

WRITE UP OF SCHEME OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT THROUGH POLYTECHNICS.

Community Development through Polytechnics (CDTP) Scheme of Govt. of India, is 100% centrally sponsored scheme. Short term training programmes of 3 to 6 month duration are being run through 16 Govt./ Govt. Aided Polytechnics & their extension centres to train 600 candidates per polytechnic per annum. The target groups under the scheme includes SC, ST, OBC, Minority, Women Person with disabilities, Economically weaker section and other disadvantaged section of the society.

As scheme is 100% centrally sponsored scheme, targets are achieved by the respective polytechnics as per the availability of funds.

Training schedule: Short term training programmes of 3 to 6 month duration throughout the year

Budget Provision:

This is a 100% centrally sponsored scheme. There is a provision of Rs. 200 Lacs per year under CDTP Scheme. As and when the grant is released by the Ministry, the same is transferred to the concerned institutions. Grant to be released by the Ministry is not fixed. Every year budget provision is made tentatively. **Earlier, Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD) was implementing the CDTP scheme. As per decision taken in the central cabinet, all work related to CDTP scheme has been transferred from MHRD to Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) in July 2017 and scheme is being reviewed by them. During FY 2019-20 no grant has been released by MSDE.**

Cost per candidate: As per the provision of the scheme, training cost per candidate comes out to Rs. 2800/- per candidate approximately.
